

## Essay 3: Peer Critique

Write out your peer critique **on a separate page**. At the top of the page place the author's name and your own name as shown:

II. Read the draft again slowly and respond to the following with brief, specific explanations on a separate page.

1. Summarize the essay in one or two sentences.
2. Make an outline of the essay's organization.
3. List at least **three** specific things the essay points out about the scene that a casual reader would not have noticed.
4. Briefly make the strongest case you can **refuting** the essay's thesis.

III. List at least three major **strong points** and three major **weak areas** of the draft.
